Short project description:	This project would provide the young people we work alongside with the equipment needed to maintain their bikes. Our young people rely heavily on bikes as their primary mode of transport and often fall into disrepair with no funding options to purchase new ones. We hope that by providing them with the equipment/knowledge to maintain their bikes, they will have access to a sustainable mode of transport.
	The funds will purchase 1x bike repair kit and 1x portable tyre pump for each of the 13 young people currently in our service and 2x spares in case of breakage. Once the items had been purchased, an existing member of staff with bike maintenance knowledge will deliver sessions to the young people on puncture repairs and basic bike maintenance. The staff member would also provide regular maintenance advice when needed and the items purchased would belong to the young people to keep after move-on from service.
	We expect the project to start as soon as funds are received. Existing staff will purchase the equipment in line with internal grant spend monitoring procedures and organise regular maintenance sessions in line with staffing/capacity requirements.
