Please describe how your grant was used:

We asked for the funding to go towards our Saturday Club which is a social club for autistic children aged 8-11yrs. They come to the club every other Saturday for 2hrs to give their parent/carers a break from their caring responsibilities and also for the children to meet new friends and try new activities in a space conducive to their needs.

How many people benefited from your project/activity or attended if it was an event?

64 autistic children have accessed the Saturday Club in the past 12 months, however, the reach of benefit is far wider as the parent/carers can spend the 2hrs with either their other children, go shopping or just have time to themselves to re-charge.

What was the outcome of your grant?

We have been able to provide opportunities for autistic children to try new things, learn new skills, discover hidden talents and develop friendships in a safe and fun environment without worry or prejudice. Below is an outcome ladder which shows the development of the children from when their 1<sup>st</sup> access the Saturday club to where they are now – as can be seen all the scores have had a positive affect.

Space4autism ... are amazing too. My son attends several of their clubs, we access support when necessary and always feel welcome when we just drop in for a coffee.

Just want to say how impressed we are with the Space4Autism groups our daughter has been attending on Saturday morning. She really enjoys the sessions. It is a great place where she can really be herself.

XXX counts down the days on his calendar to the next SPACE meeting. He is doing what other kids do, having fun and has made a good friend here. He can walk in and be free at SPACE, it is not like a school common room where there may be bullies, and fear. It is an unencumbered safe environment for him.

What have you learned from this project?

We have been running the Saturday club for over 6 years now and from the outcomes that are achieved we know we are doing something right, however, as the clubs are so successful there is always a huge demand, more people wanted to take part in activities than we were able to cope with. We have seen our social clubs grow over the years to try to cope – we are currently running a total of 8 different social clubs for people of all ages and we will monitor demand and shape provision accordingly wherever possible. However, due to ever decreasing funding streams we may have to reduce the clubs we offer which would have a devastating affect on not only the children who attend but also the parents/carers.
